CALL FOR ENTRIES

Dear Crafter:

The Paisley Farmhouse is pleased to announce our Spring Handmade Market Craft Fair on Saturday, May 1st, 2010, from 10a.m. – 5p.m. **We are calling to crafters, antique vendors, food vendors, etc. to apply to our show.**

Returning crafters know that our Handmade Market is a wonderful experience for all involved. If you are new to the event, we encourage you to consider spending the day with us at The Paisley Farmhouse. It will be a great time to be visible to Mother's Day shoppers and to kickoff the summer season, and we will do all we can for you to have a productive day with a fun festive setting.

To apply to participate in the Spring Handmade Market Craft Fair please complete the enclosed Craft Application/Contract and return as directed with photos and payment no later than April 16th, 2010. If your application is accepted, you will receive notification of your acceptance and booth fees will then be deposited. If we choose not to accept you at this time, you will be notified and booth fees will not be deposited. Those who apply after the April 16th deadline will be given consideration on a space available basis.

This is a juried show and crafters chosen to participate in the Spring Handmade Market Craft Fair are skilled artisans who provide our shoppers with an array of unique art. All applicants are carefully reviewed and judged for individual merit. The photos and description you provide with your application are used for judging. Previous Handmade Market participation is not considered and we cannot provide exhibitors the opportunity to reserve a space or obtain the same space for consecutive years. This show is fairly small with only 20-25 vendors, so we will only be able to accept 1 or 2 vendors who fall in similar categories.

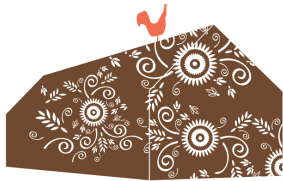
There are a few differences this show compared to our past shows. For example, each sale will now not be handled through The Paisley Farmhouse checkout center. Each vendor will handle his or her own transactions at their booth as most shows do. This change has been brought on to avoid long lines forming at the one checkout station. We will also not be charging any percentage of sales to the vendors- the booth fee is the only fee. Additionally, all accepted crafters will be asked to donate one item (at check-in) on the day of the show for door prizes that will be won by customers. Feel free to include any promotional information with your product donation.

BOOTH INFORMATION: _____ Single Booth approx. 10 x 10 \$65

SHOW: The Spring Handmade market Craft Fair will take place on Saturday, May 1, 2010, 10am-5pm. A “gully-washer” rain date of Saturday, May 8th has been set. Setting up may begin around 8am. There can be no setting up the day before the show. Please stay with your booth for the entire show.

BOOTH SPACE: All spaces are outdoors on pavement and measure approx. 10 ft by 10ft. Most vendors bring a 10’x10’ tent (weighted with water jugs or sand bags) to protect from sun and rain. There is no electricity available to vendor booths.

SALES: You will handle all your own transactions and sales tax as a vendor. It is your decision whether you accept checks, credit cards, or PayPal in addition to cash. You should have plenty of change on hand. Please do not ask any shops, restaurants, fellow vendors, or Publix for change. There is a Suntrust and a Wachovia nearby, although they close early on Saturday.

TABLES/CHAIRS/TENTS: Please provide your own tables, tents, props, and backdrops as needed.

DOOR PRIZE: We ask that each vendor provide a door prize at check-in.

Application Requirements:

1. Submit completed & signed contract. Please make a copy for your records.
2. Submit no more than 4 photos of your work. Photos will not be returned.
3. Submit booth fee to The Paisley Farmhouse. Payment of \$65 should be made by check or credit card. Checks are cashed / credit cards are processed upon approval. Mail or drop off your completed application, photos and payment to:

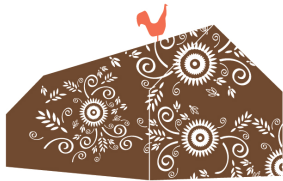
